PROHIBITORY ORDER

WHEREAS, it has been reported that, there are unusual mortalities of pigs in many districts of Arunachal Pradesh, and adjoining districts of Assam. The matter has been taken very seriously by the Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Gol. Sensing the grievous nature of the incident, the Government of Assam has dispatched a lot of Lab. Samples to National Institute of High Security Animal Disease, Bhopal, through special chartered plane, for confirmatory diagnosis. The lab. specimen from Arunachal Pradesh have also been sent to NERDD, Guwahati, for onward submission to NIHSAD, Bhopal.

WHEREAS, after going through the letter received from Gol, vide No- K-11025/26/2019-LH, Dated 18th April, 2020, and investigation reports received from the department officers, and reports flashed in electronic media, it is considered that strict precautionary measures are to be adhered till confirmatory results are obtained from NIHSAD, Bhopal.

THEREFORE, keeping in view the prevailing situation, a prohibitory order cum public advisory is hereby issued to be strictly followed in the entire state of Arunachal Pradesh:

1. The selling of live pig/ pork meat is completely banned in the entire state of Arunachal Pradesh till further order.
2. Inter-state/ inter-District transportation of pig/ pork meat/ pork meat product are completely banned in the entire state of Arunachal Pradesh till further order.
3. All the pigs are to be kept in close confinement, maintaining hygienic/ bio-security measures.
4. Any sick or mortality in pig may be reported to the nearest veterinary institute (VAC/VD/VH/DIO/DAH&VO).
5. No carcass of pig or any other livestock shall be abandoned or thrown by the owner. It is the responsibility of the owner to bury it properly in a deep pit with lime / bleaching powder/ phenyl sprinkled over the carcass.
6. Any death seen in wild pig/boar, may be intimated to nearest veterinary institute immediately.
7. The District Magistrate of respective districts is requested to implement this prohibitory order in letter and spirit. Any violation to this order may be dealt strictly as per the provision of the law.
